This letter is to advise all parents of children attending Harding School of the proper procedures for the dropping off of their children for class on school days. It is our hope that we can eliminate some of the traffic issues created during the drop off/pickup of children before they happen and make the school zone safer and more efficient for everyone. Below is a list of what will be enforced by officers and what would be expected of parents. Thank you for your co-operation.

N 18th St from the Boulevard along the side of Harding School & the Boulevard from N 18th St to the Harding School Loop entrance will be pick-up and drop off zones only. Parents may pull up to the curb and drop off or pick up their children. Children should only exit or enter on the passengers side of the vehicle when dropped off on the Boulevard. When children are dropped off or picked up on N 18th St, Children should only exit or enter on the drivers side on the vehicle. No vehicle shall remain stopped for any length of time. This will speed the process and assist in traffic delays.

No vehicle shall be left un-occupied.

No left turns exiting the school drop off/ pick up loop onto the Boulevard East

No left turns entering the school drop off/ pick up loop for East bound Boulevard traffic

Parking of vehicles in the area of the school:

No vehicles shall block driveways or be parked alongside any yellow curb.

If crossing the Boulevard on foot, or Crossing N 19th St, the crosswalks located at N 19th St or Coolidge Dr shall be utilized. No Pedestrian crossing of the Boulevard in front of the school and no one shall cross in the middle of N 19th St from the Kenilworth Market Lot to the Santander Bank Lot.
